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In 2015 we adopted a new three-year ASI Strategy. The Strategy launched a number of major projects aimed to promote Russia's economic development and improve the quality of people's live. The Strategy is based on the experience that we have gained since the establishment of the Agency. But most importantly, it is based on the community of like-minded people surrounding the ASI. Without these people, our core asset, it is hardly possible to make our plans come true.

The National Technology Initiative has already brought together thousands of people, including entrepreneurs and experts, scientists and teachers, representatives of the government and wider public, adults and children. Having marked 2035 on the horizon, we all started to think – on what fundamentally new markets Russia can become a global leader? And what – specifically, step by step – should be done to achieve this? In 2015, the first road maps to develop the markets of the unmanned (ground, air and water) vehicles and neurotechnologies were elaborated, starting the extensive work on their coordination among all implementing parties.

This is the future that is being created here and now. This will be the reality for

our children. It is them who are to develop these promising markets, design unmanned ships and vehicles, expand the scope of knowledge on our brain and its capabilities, and create the technologies and tools that we even cannot imagine today. But our children need to be prepared for this. A new model for supplementary education that we developed in collaboration with experts and educators should spark children's interest towards research and discovery, acquaint them with the concept of how things work, and incentivize accomplishments. This model implies creating across Russia a network of modern-equipped technology parks for children. In 2015, three technology parks of this kind were opened.

Personnel training system needs to be tailored specifically to the modern economy and the economy of the future. We can try to make this idea sound clearer by referring specifically to the working professions, but the distinction between the "white" and "blue" collars, as well as specialized secondary and higher engineering education, is fading now. Professional skills competitions, which have been attracting tens of thousands of spec-





tators for several years now, clearly show that, for example, the welder of today is a top-class specialist working on an immensely complex equipment. Professionals of this kind should be trained in accordance with the latest international standards. And our participation in the WorldSkills International movement is an opportunity to get a unique experience and learn best practices in vocational education.

In 2015 Russia won the bid to host the 2019 WorldSkills Competition in Kazan. We surely want to see our team perform well, but it will require much effort. The issue of personnel training is closely watched by Vladimir Putin, the President of Russia and the Chairman of the Supervisory Board of the ASI, personally. Addressing to the Federal Assembly on December 3, 2015, President Putin stressed the importance of the professional skills competitions and proposed to call this whole framework "Young Professionals".

Entrepreneurs note the deficit of the high-skilled workers as one of the main obstacles to business development. The "hot-button" issues also include the persisting administrative barriers,

bureaucracy, lack of the essential infrastructure, insufficient or non-working supporting measures. The barometer, which measures the quality of the business environment in each region, is the National Regional Investment Climate Index. In 2015, it covered the majority of the regions (the pilot Index in 2014 covered 21 regions). The Index revealed the strengths and weaknesses of the regional management teams, and became the source of the best practices and the basis for an educational program (implemented jointly with the Russian Presidential Academy of National Economy and Public Administration).

The Index covers the efforts of all levels of government in a territory – not only the efforts of regional authorities. It is very important to see how the federal-level changes work in a particular region of the Russian Federation. It came clear that performance varies from region to region, though the law is the same for all. We believe this should not be the case. It took much effort to develop and implement the road maps of the National Business Initiative, and most of the planned activities (including, amendments to the legislation) were completed in 2015, while the monitoring is in progress. Through constant communication with the business community, we have further identified a number of complex issues that need to be addressed within the framework of the NBI.

Those are not only the issues of connection to water and gas, improve-

ment of corporate legislation, but also the need for additional tools to support the non-oil-and-gas exports. This is how the "Investment Lift" appeared – a "single-window" service for potential exporters helping to get both advice and funding. At the end of 2015, first five companies were supported under this mechanism.

A separate, but no less important topic for the ASI is to secure a new quality of life for people with disabilities. Within this project, we plan to support domestic manufacturers of rehabilitation equipment and organize a system of individual tailoring of assistive devices for each disabled person. At first glance, there are many initiatives, and they are very different. But in fact, all streams of our work are interconnected, working together and complementing the projects of our colleagues. What unites us is that we want to build a country where everyone would love to live and work. Yeah, just like this.

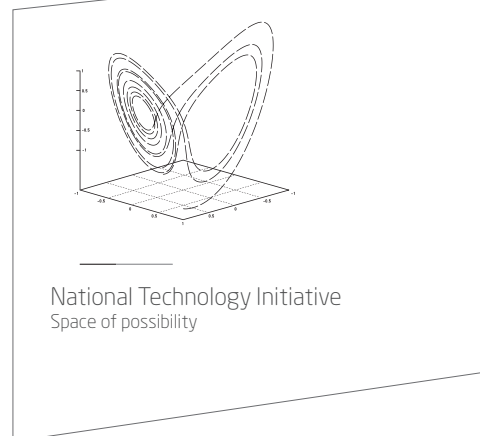

CRITERIA FOR DEFINING MARKETS:

Successful development of these markets in Russia, as well as appearance of the national high-tech companies capable of producing goods and services that will be competitive globally, is largely dependent on forming the country's scientific and technological advantage in the key NTI technologies, and on training talented technicians and entrepreneurs in for the NTI activities. It is also requiring coordinated efforts of the government institutions that are working to support high-tech companies at all levels.

That is why the key axes of the NTI Matrix are Technologies, Talents and Services.

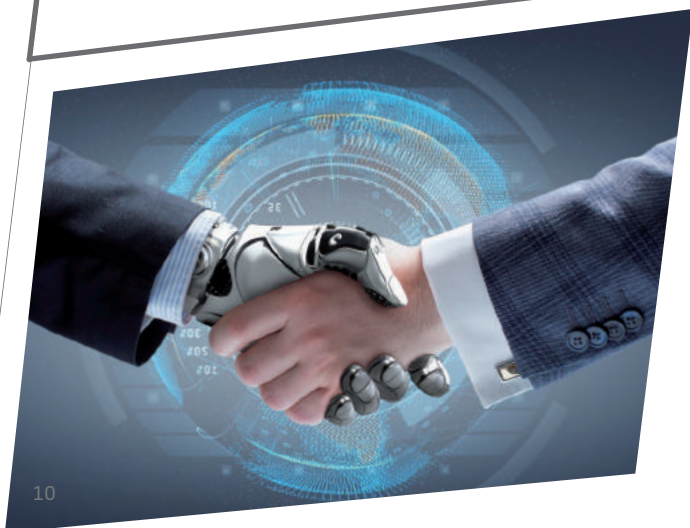
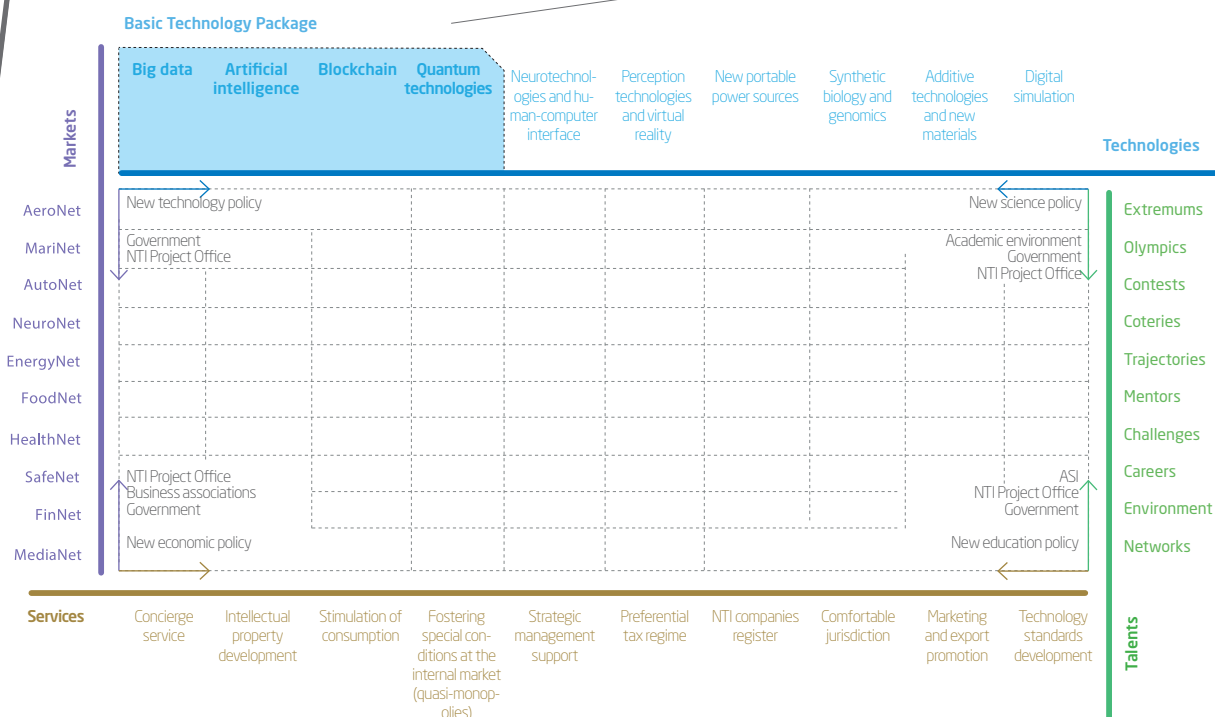
THE NTI WORK GROUPS ARE:

"In 2015, the work on the National Technology Initiative covered clarification and specification of the NTI model, development of the road maps, designing and development of certain initiatives in the areas such as "Technologies", "Services", "Talents". 2015 was the year for starting the creation of the NTI community of technological entrepreneurs, active representatives of the scientific, educational and development institutions, federal and regional authorities.

Our next step is developing the NTI strategy and management system. Launching a national long-term project requires solving a whole range of issues, from ensuring the leadership in new technologies and searching for partners worldwide to developing the culture patterns that will encourage the society to move forward and holding public campaigns. We will have to merge the efforts of the business community, government and wider public, as well as Russia's international partners to address these issues collectively".

NTI SERVICES

High-tech businesses in the prospective NTI markets will need different kinds and types of the government support. This will include building technoparks, providing venture capital financing, export promotion, technology transfer support, popularization, public procurement, intellectual property registration and even more. All of these is not a goal in itself, but a service focused on boosting the development of the national high-tech companies.

NTI TALENTS

the NTI model reflects on the task of providing companies with a new type of human resources from two perspectives. On the one hand, it seeks to identify the competencies needed to generate breakthrough solutions for the prospective markets. On the other hand, it looks into building the system for early detection and development of talents, creating the environment helping these talents to realize their potentials.

Within the "NTI Talents" streams, a number of projects such as the NTI Academic Competition have already been launched. In 2016, it is planned to give start to the "NTI universities" and projects aimed at professional guidance for children, new educational formats to identify natural sciences talents, support their development and advancement in the fields of the NTI. In 2016 we will also present the final composition of the projects on the "NTI Talents" scale.

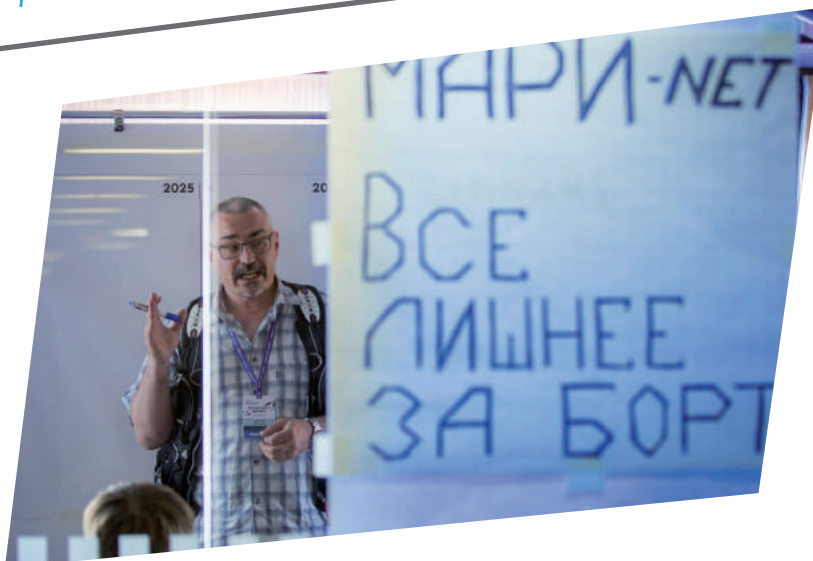

The main thing is compliance with the selection criteria and the company's commitment to constant development".

Kazan's bid received more votes than the bids from Paris, France and Charleroi, Belgium. The victory of the Russian bid to host the WorldSkills International in 2019 based on the systematic preparatory work and provision of the government guarantees for developing the WorldSkills movement and holding WSI-2019 in Russia.

The Russian national team took part in the 43rd WorldSkills Competition, having come 14th in the overall standings (27 positions up compared to the previous Competition) and won 6 prestigious Medallions of Excellence (mechatronics, electrical works, hairstyling, cooking, restaurant service, network and system administration).

PURPOSE OF THE INITIATIVE IS TO FORM A NEW MODEL OF SOCIALIZATION FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES THROUGH THEIR ACCESS TO HIGH-TECH AND HIGH-QUALITY REHABILITATION EQUIPMENT AND IMPROVE QUALITY OF RENDERED REHABILITATIVE AND HABILITATIVE SERVICES.

"The strategic initiative "New Quality of Life of People with Disabilities" received a powerful impetus to development thanks to the approval by the Agency's Supervisory Board. In accordance with instructions of the President of the Russian Federation to the Government of the Russian Federation, it is necessary to launch pilot projects on state-and-private partnership on the establishment of up-to-date rehabilitation equipment by July 1, 2016.

Development of Russian rehabilitation equipment market and quality improvement of services for people with disabilities gives hope for considerable changes in their quality of life, both in terms of rehabilitation equipment, and in terms of socialization and integration of these people into social life".

* Exoskeleton is a device designed to compensate for lost functions, increase muscle strength and extend the range of motion due to the external carcass and driving elements.





IMPROVING INVESTMENT CLIMATE AND SUPPORTING INVESTORS

THE

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NATIONAL ENTREPRENEURIAL INITIATIVE

The following key reforms have been implemented under the roadmaps of the National Entrepreneurial Initiative (NEI) in 2015: canceled compulsory seals of commercial companies; improved procedure for state cadastral valuation (hereinafter referred to as the "State Cadastral Valuation") in the administration of the pre-trial order to challenge its results; canceled business trip certificates; "Russian Export Centre" created, acting as a "single window", to provide for financial and non-financial export support; reduced cost of technological connection due to reduction by 50% of the construction costs of the "last mile", and others.

Implementation of NEI roadmaps resulted in Russia's rise by 11 positions in the World Bank's Doing Business Rating in 2015: from 62th to 51th positions!

The time of easy victories has passed: the higher the position of Russia in the rating, the more difficult further progress is. The main legislation activity in the framework of NEI was completed in 2015. NEI project moves into the law enforcement assessment stage, when it is necessary to evaluate the result of what has already been done in practice, and to propose corrective measures where there are still some problems.

"It is extremely important that all changes were not just "on paper" (indeed, this is true, all my business contacts confirm that), but in real life, as they are felt in business. 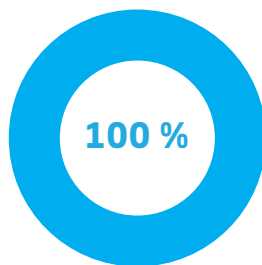

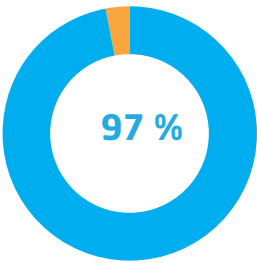

"Basic roadmap indicators have been achieved, but the work is in progress. According to the Ministry of Economic Development, the average volume of purchases of 35 largest state-owned companies from small and medium-size businesses in 2015 amounted to 36.2% of the overall purchases, which is 2 times exceeds the norm set by the Government of the Russian Federation. Our task now is to ensure that the documents are enforced in practice, not just on paper.

The roadmap has been further developed in a new project to create the territorial and industrial clusters at the state-owned companies with the assistance of small and medium-size businesses through a competitive procedure. State-owned companies will grow their own pool of manufacturers supplying companies with associated components. The project will be implemented with the support of AO Corporation MSP.

In the nomination "Obtaining the Construction Permits", the Russian Federation managed to rise up from 178 to 119 position compared to the year of 2012. Despite the formal expiry of the term of the roadmap implementation, the members of the work group expressed their unequivocal opinion and desire to continue this format of work; moreover, there are many difficult issues yet. On December 1, 2015 at the meeting with Prime Minister of the Russian Federation, it was decided to continue the work under the roadmap on construction and amendments to the current roadmap.

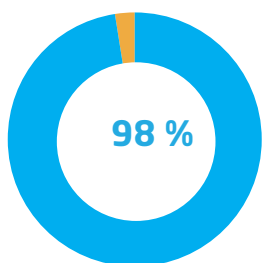

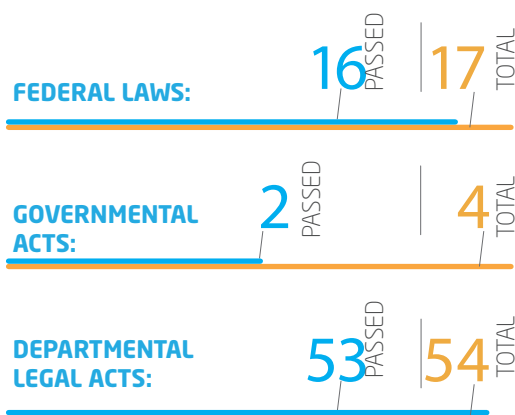

"In 2015, the work on the implementation of the roadmap activities was almost completed, which were associated with the development and adoption of federal laws and regulations.

Last year, the work group has achieved one of the key objectives to reform and develop the Russian accounting and registration system, namely, provision by the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre and Cartography of public services in the electronic form. Business and citizens now have an opportunity to get via the Internet any of the four public services and to completely eliminate the need for an office visit and interaction with the officer.

The success of the roadmap implementation has been confirmed by the annual Doing Business rating. At the "Property Registration" nomination, Russia was included in the top ten countries assessed in the "Doing Business" survey.

"Another year of bulk rule-making work has passed. In 2017, everyone who will contact the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre and Cartography, will feel it. Until then, we can take advantage of online services rendered by the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre and Cartography, including property registration ones. The experience of this road map confirms once again that this result does not need individual adjustment of legislation, but a complete, detailed reform plan with a horizon of 5-7 years".

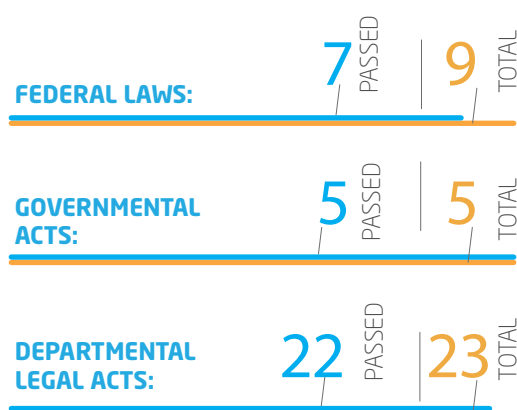

Since 2014, the Agency has been actively involved in the work of the coordinating bodies of interstate association BRICS, in particular, in the activities of the BRICS Business Council. The personnel training group from Russia is being guided by the Agency.

In 2015, a group of agriculture and elimination of excessive administrative barriers (deregulation work group) was formed.

MARCH 2015

In March 2015, the investment potential of the Russian Federation was presented in the UK (London). The event was attended by over 150 representatives of the UK business community, and more than 25 bilateral meetings were held with British entrepreneurs.

JUNE 2015

In June 2015, the investment potential of the Russian Federation was presented in Japan (Tokyo). Heads of 8 constituent entities of the Russian Federation spoke about the investment potential of their territories to the Japanese investors. More than 100 people participated in the event, among them the representatives of the government, diplomatic corps, business associations and business leaders.

JULY 2015

The proposals were discussed by the heads of the national parts of the board at the meeting of the BRICS Business Council in the framework of the summit in Ufa on July 7-8, 2015. The proposals for the optimization of business regulation were approved at the meeting of the contact group of high representatives of the BRICS on the economic and investment cooperation, set out in the road map of trade-economic and investment cooperation between the BRICS countries for the period up to 2020, and included in the body of the final declaration by the Heads of State following the results of the BRICS summit.

AUGUST 2015

During the visit of the Agency delegation to Latin America in August 2015 Chilean organizations, supervising business support, it was suggested to organize a similar seminar in Chile to inform about the conditions of doing business in Russia, it was held in October 2015.

SEPTEMBER 2015

On September 7 in the city of Tula, the Agency held a business breakfast for foreign partners along with the administration of Tula region. By the example of Tula region, detailed information on the measures and forms of state support businesses operating in the territory of the Russian Federation was provided to management of foreign companies and diplomatic corps.

OCTOBER 2015

In October 2015, a presentation was held in Germany (Munich). In total, the event was attended by about 200 German businessmen, 8 leaders of the constituent entities of the Russian Federation spoke, about 60 bilateral meetings with German businessmen passed.
